

Memorandum of Understanding for implementing the "Multifaceted Promotions Led by Art and Culture Exchanges with the ASEAN Members" project



between
Silpakorn University
and
Tokyo University of the Arts

This Memorandum is made between Tokyo University of the Arts (TUA) and Silpakorn University (SU) for the purpose of implementing the "Multifaceted Promotions Led by Art and Culture Exchanges with the ASEAN Members" project¹.

- 1. Both TUA and SU shall perform the project by conducting the following activities.
- (1) Joint classes and collaborative social practices participated in by faculty and administrative members and students from both institutions
- (2) Training programs and study abroad programs on a short-term basis participated in by faculty and administrative members, researchers, and students from both institutions
- (3) Exchange of information and materials regarding art and art education
- (4) Promotion of quality assurance in education and research at both institutions
- (5) Dissemination, promotion and communication of project outcomes as well as of the art cultures of Japan and Thailand
- (6) Efforts for establishing the network of art institutions in Japan and ASEAN countries
- (7) Other matters agreed upon by both institutions
- 2. In the actual implementation of each of the above mentioned activities, the details and methods shall be determined by prior consultation between both institutions. An implementation plan shall be drafted upon request by either institution.
- 3. The scope of responsibility and the payment method for expenses incurred for each activity shall be determined by prior consultation between both institutions.
- 4. Both institutions shall strive to ensure that the activities are carried out on an ongoing basis through various means such as acquisition of external funds.
- 5. This Memorandum shall be valid until March 31, 2021. This Memorandum may be amended by mutual consent in writing, or terminated by either institution on 6 months' prior written notice to the other institution, at any time.
- 6. This Memorandum shall be written in English. Two copies shall be made and be validated by the signatures of duly authorized representatives of both institutions. Each institution shall hold one original signed copy.
